Presence and Periodicity: The institute has a PTM committee that meets twice a year. The committee schedules meetings following review and assessment, and it uses the media to disseminate information about the meetings.

Students are also informed by the committee.

The Dean of the institute delivers the inaugural speech, outlining the vision, mission, and objectives of the institution. The primary emphasis is on discussing key factors that influence learning, including behavior development, motivation, relationships, strengths, and challenges faced by students. A performance report is prepared and presented to the parents, enabling a comprehensive evaluation. Parents are then encouraged to provide feedback on their child's strengths, areas for improvement, and suggestions for enhancing performance.
